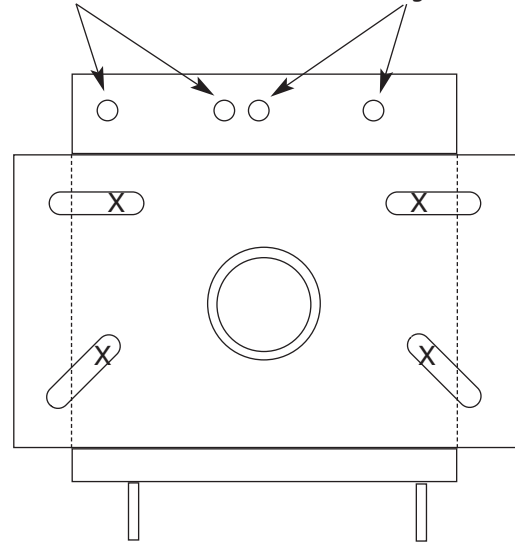


Engine Stand Adapter Plate Instructions Item# T3001-ADP

1. Position the face plate from your engine stand on the back side of the adapter (it makes drilling much easier) as shown below. Make the location for 4 holes.
2. Remove the face plate and center punch marks.
3. Drill four 7/16" holes in adapter.
4. Attach the face plate to the adapter using the four 7/16"x1" bolts, flat washer, and nuts.
5. On assembled engines the starter, water pump, and/or water inlet must be removed.
6. Mount adapter on the Model T engine block using two 7/16"x3/4" bolts in the water pump or water inlet casting holes.
7. Attach face plate to engine stand in normal manner, and you're ready to go to work.

Use these holes for better balance when transmission is attached.

Use these holes for better balance when holding only the engine block.

Texas T Parts will repair or replace any part that we manufacture, for a period of 90 days from the date of purchase, that wears out or breaks.

Return any part directly to us, along with a copy of the sales receipt showing the date of purchase, and \$5 to cover shipping & handling. Do not return parts to your dealer.
