

Day 2

Monday, June 25th LOVELAND TO GRANBY

Approximately 90 miles

Leave Loveland at 8:00 AM on U.S. Highway 34 (Eisenhower) west, travel 27 miles to Estes park.

We will stop in Estes Park at the City Parking Lot. You may want to spend some time in Estes Park.

Leave no later than 10:00 AM, west on U.S. Highway 34 (main street of Estes Park).

Continue on U.S. Highway 34 (Trail Ridge Road) 25 miles to the Trail Ridge Visitor Center Area for Lunch.

NOTE:

There are lots of overlooks to enjoy on this trip. At Lava Cliffs you can see Iceberg Lake, which will still be frozen over. Some other neat overlooks are Rainbow Curve, Rock Cut, Many Parks Curve and Gore Range Overlook (the highest point on Trail Ridge Road at 12,183 feet).

After Lunch **continue west** on U.S. Highway 34 to Grand Lake.

Approximately 4 miles after the Visitor Center Area (and much lower elevation) you will reach the Continental Divide (Milner Pass).

NOTE:

You may want to stop and take a picture at Poudre Lake. At this point the water on the northeast side of Milner Pass flows to the Atlantic and the water on the south west side of Milner Pass flows to the Pacific.

After leaving this area we will continue another 20 miles and make a stop in Grand Lake.

You can take as much time as you like touring the various shops.

After spending some time in Grand Lake continue southwest on U.S. Highway 34 to Granby (16 Miles). You will come to U.S. Highway 40 at Granby.

Turn Left (east) on U.S. Highway 40 and travel through the town of Granby.

The Silver Creek Lodge is on the east side (left) of U.S. Highway #40 about 4 miles east of Granby.

NOTE:

This may very well be the most scenic 90 miles you have ever driven in your Model T. Leave plenty of time on this day to stop at the many pull offs on Trail Ridge Road,
