

Day 3

Tuesday, June 26th GRANBY TO STEAMBOAT SPRINGS

Approximately 81 Miles

Leave the Silver Creek Lodge and turn right (west) on U.S. Highway 40. Travel through Granby staying on U.S. Highway 40.

Arrive at Hot Sulphur Springs, 11 miles from Granby.

The next town is Kremmling, 17 miles from the Hot Springs.

You may want to grab a snack here, fill up your gas tank and use the restrooms, as there are no other facilities for the next 53 miles

Continue on U.S. Highway 40 for 53 miles to the town of Steamboat Springs.

You will travel over Rabbit Ears Pass. On the way you cross the Continental Divide twice. (Pacific to Atlantic @ Muddy Pass, elevation 8772 and Atlantic to Pacific @ Rabbit Ears Pass, elevation 9426).

NOTE:

Rabbit Ears Pass was named after the twin peaks to your right (north).

You may want to stop at one of the higher overlooks and take some pictures of Steamboat Springs Valley. Also, you may want to ride the Tramway to the Top of Werner Mountain, which you can see when you are coming down Rabbit Ears Pass.

There will be ample time to visit the many unique shops in Steamboat.

The Super Eight Motel is on your left just as you enter town.
