

## Day 5

### Thursday June 28<sup>th</sup> SARATOGA TO WALDEN

Approximately 111 Miles

Leave Saratoga south on Wyoming Highway 130 and drive for 8 miles.

Turn left ( east) still on Wyoming Highway 130 for approximately 22 miles to the top of Snowy Range.

**NOTE:** When you reach the summit of the Snowy Range Scenic Byway you will see the Libby Flats observation point, and the Medicine Bow Peak overlook. Libby Flats provides a breath-taking panoramic view to the south allowing the visitor to see as far as the Rawah and Never Summer Wilderness areas in Colorado.

The Snowy Range was voted the third most scenic bypass in the United States.

From the observation pavilion turn around west and go back down on Wyoming Highway 130 to the intersection.

Turn south (left) 10 miles to Riverside & Encampment.

You may want to have lunch here.

There is also an interesting pioneer village that if you have time you may visit in Encampment.

Leave Riverside and drive south 27 miles to the Colorado State Line.

Continue south on Colorado 125 for 22 miles, to Walden.

**NOTE:** Watch for large sand dunes about 10 miles north of Walden on the Mountains to your left.
