

DAY 6

Friday June 29th WALDEN TO LOVELAND

Approximately 111 Miles

Leave Walden on CO. Highway 14 East.(Leave early to miss the evening commuter traffic around Ft. Collins)

Stop at the Moose Visitor Center in about 15 miles.

They keep an hourly chart on the latest moose and elk sightings. You may want to get a photo of your Model T beside the full sized barbed wire moose.

NOTE: This will be the last rest stop for many miles.

You begin your climb up Cameron Pass as you leave the Moose Visitor Center.

There is some spectacular scenery along this stretch of road. You may want to make some stops near the top for photo shots.

Once you reach the top, you will begin a long, steady descent along the Cache LaPoudre River.

When you get to the Cache LaPoudre Cascades you may want to walk down the trail about 20 yards and watch the cascades.

56 miles from Walden, you will reach Rustic.

You can purchase gas and have lunch here

Leave Rustic and travel 31 miles to Ted's Corner (at the intersection of U.S. Highway 287 and CO Highway 14).

From Ted's Corner turn right (south) on U.S. Highway 297 for 4 miles.

You will soon see a large green sign to La Porte. Don't turn there, but look for your next turn.

A little later you will see a small green state road information sign that says: "La Porte and N. Overland Trail".

Turn right (south) on North Overland Trail (Larimer county road 21 C), which winds (several curves) through northwest Fr. Collins.

You will follow North Overland Trail for 6.8 Miles.

Watch for a yellow sign that says NO OUTLET ahead of you.

Here you will turn left (east) onto Drake Road go 1 mile to Taft Hill road (2nd signal light).

Turn right (south at the stoplight) onto Taft Hill Road. Go 10 miles to U.S. Highway 34.

NOTE: Taft Hill Road becomes Wilson Road in Loveland.

At Highway 34 turn left (east) travel 3 miles back to the motels.

Total tour mileage 519 Miles
